REDUCTION IN ER VISITS

Studies indicate that without poison centers, over 50% of suspected poisoning cases would like end up in emergency rooms, causing millions of dollars in unnecessary medical costs.

POISON CENTERS LOWER COSTS FOR HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS

Florida's Poison Control Centers co-managing patients at health care facilities was documented to reduce hospital charges by approximately: \$103,450,000/year.

These cost savings resulted in a:

WHAT DOES ALL THIS MEAN?

With the help of state and federal funding, an investment of \$7,654,414 in Florida Poison Centers saves over \$486,567,766 per year in health care costs, resources and unnecessary medical treatment.

\$7,654,414 -= \$486,567,766 IN HEALTH CARE SAVINGS ANNUALLY
