POISON CONTROL CENTER CELEBRATES 25th ANNIVERSARY IN CONJUNCTION WITH NATIONAL POISON PREVENTION WEEK

JACKSONVILLE, FL (March 15, 2018) — The Florida/USVI Poison Information Center - Jacksonville is celebrating a special anniversary during National Poison Prevention Week, March 18th through the 24th.

This year marks the 25th anniversary of the center initiating 24-hour service, available to assist the public around the clock. The center is kicking off National Poison Prevention Week by hosting a celebration on the UF Health Jacksonville campus to commemorate the anniversary.

"All of us are honored to have the opportunity to provide quality care to millions of Florida residents over the past quarter century." said Dr. Jay L. Schauben, Director of the Florida/USVI Poison Information Center – Jacksonville. "In the last 25 years some of our functions have changed. We are now directly involved in public health surveillance and as a support arm of the Florida Department of Health during a public health event/emergency. What has not changed is our commitment to our patients and health care professionals using our services, and the dedication to reducing accidental poisonings through public education."

In addition to hosting a 25th anniversary event at UF Health Jacksonville on Monday, Center staff in collaboration with local partners will host events throughout National Poison Prevention Week. Poison Center education staff along with the student chapter of the Florida Society of Health-System Pharmacists/University of Florida College of Pharmacy will provide poison prevention information and free educational materials to the public. Poison Prevention Tabling Nemours Children's Clinic First Floor Lobby 9am to 4pm In 2017, the three Centers comprising the Florida Poison Information Center Network handled 135,914 incoming calls, including 108,428 that were reported as known or possible exposures to potentially toxic substances (drugs, chemicals, bites/stings, food poisoning, etc.). More than 86% of those who called with poison emergencies from home were managed safely at home without the need for an emergency room facility visit. Statewide, the Florida Poison Information Center Network saved an estimated \$299 million dollars in health care costs by reducing unnecessary emergency room visits and by helping to get patients admitted to a hospital for poisoning discharged sooner.
